

Using Single Sign-On

What is Single Sign-On?

Single sign-on (SSO) is a user authentication process that permits a user to enter name and password once, which then allows access to multiple applications. You will no longer be prompted to enter multiple passwords to all your devices, systems and applications, during and in between particular sessions.

What Projectplace offers

- ✓ An enterprise user can login to the corporate network with their ordinary login credentials, using the method they have set up. In most cases a password but it could be anything from digital certificates to tokens; defined by the enterprise customer.
- ✓ Users can automatically be created while logging in if the account does not exist, some user information can then also be updated directly from the customer's user directory, like name, phone and address.
- ✓ Advanced features - conditional provisioning, limited project creation rights.

Benefits

Single Sign-on provides your users with an easy way of signing into Projectplace. It removes the need to remember and enter a password everytime a users access the Projectplace service; either through the login page or by clicking on a project link.

With Just-in-Time provisioning, you can use a SAML assertion to create users on the fly the first time they try to log in, and simultaneously make sure those users have the appropriate account privileges. For example, if you recently added an employee to your organization, you don't need to manually create the user in Projectplace. When they log in with single sign-on, their account is automatically created for them, eliminating the time and effort with on-boarding the account. This greatly simplifies the integration work required and reduces the cost of user administration.

Additionally, any password policies that you have established for your corporate network are also in effect for Projectplace; ensuring the same security level is maintained.
