What's New in Projectplace March 2017

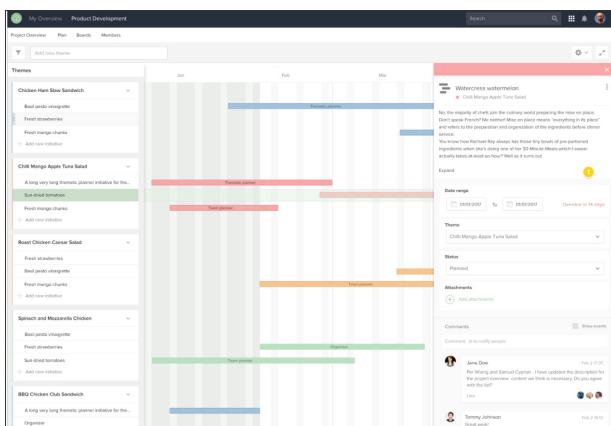

- Performance enhancements

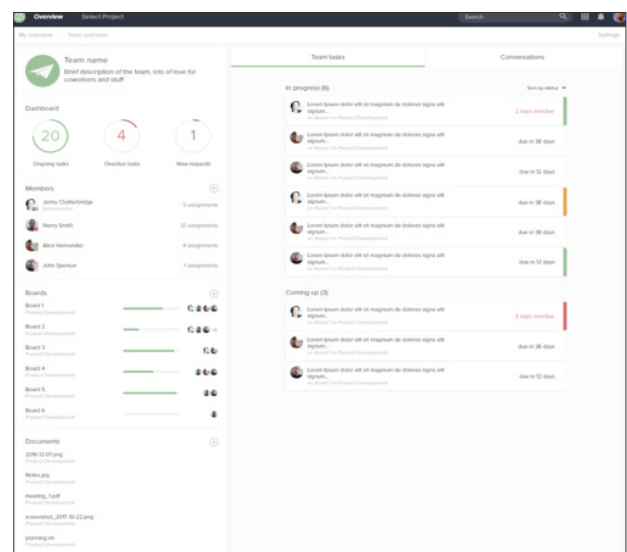
Roadmap Workspaces
