What's New in Projectplace

The December 2015 release of Projectplace brings several enhancements to the service. The highlights are:

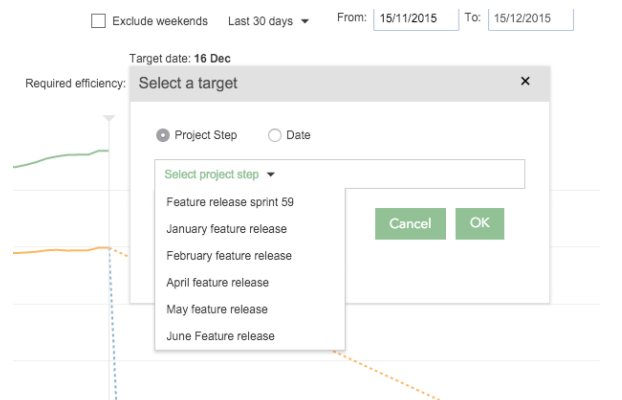
- Ability to filter dashboards by project step
- Points added to Dashboard widgets for Cumulative flow and Cycle time

Dashboards

The dashboard section within Projectplace provides a clear visualization of how the project is progressing.

In addition to being able to see Dashboard for the whole project, you can now view Dashboard based on a smaller project step, e.g. a sprint.

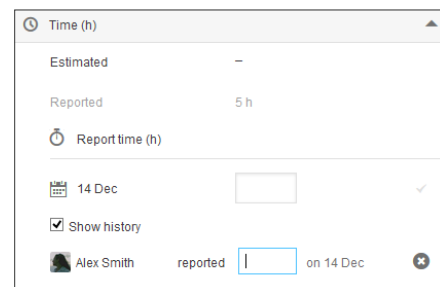
In addition, time and point estimates are now visible in Dashboard for the Cumulative flow and Cycle time widgets. Previously, users were only able to follow the number of cards for a specific period, and can now follow number of points. Considering each card can contain different number of points, this view gives a more detailed picture of reality.



Time reporting on cards

It is now possible to update the time previously reported on cards.

This gives project managers a clear and up-to-date view of actual vs. estimated time in the project, enabling them to quickly check for bottlenecks, potential risk of delay, discuss commitments and work situations within teams and with individuals to form the basis for decision-making and potential redistribution of work.



Android document review

Providing users with a more complete mobile experience in Android, document review is now available in the Projectplace Android app, in addition to document overview announced in November.
